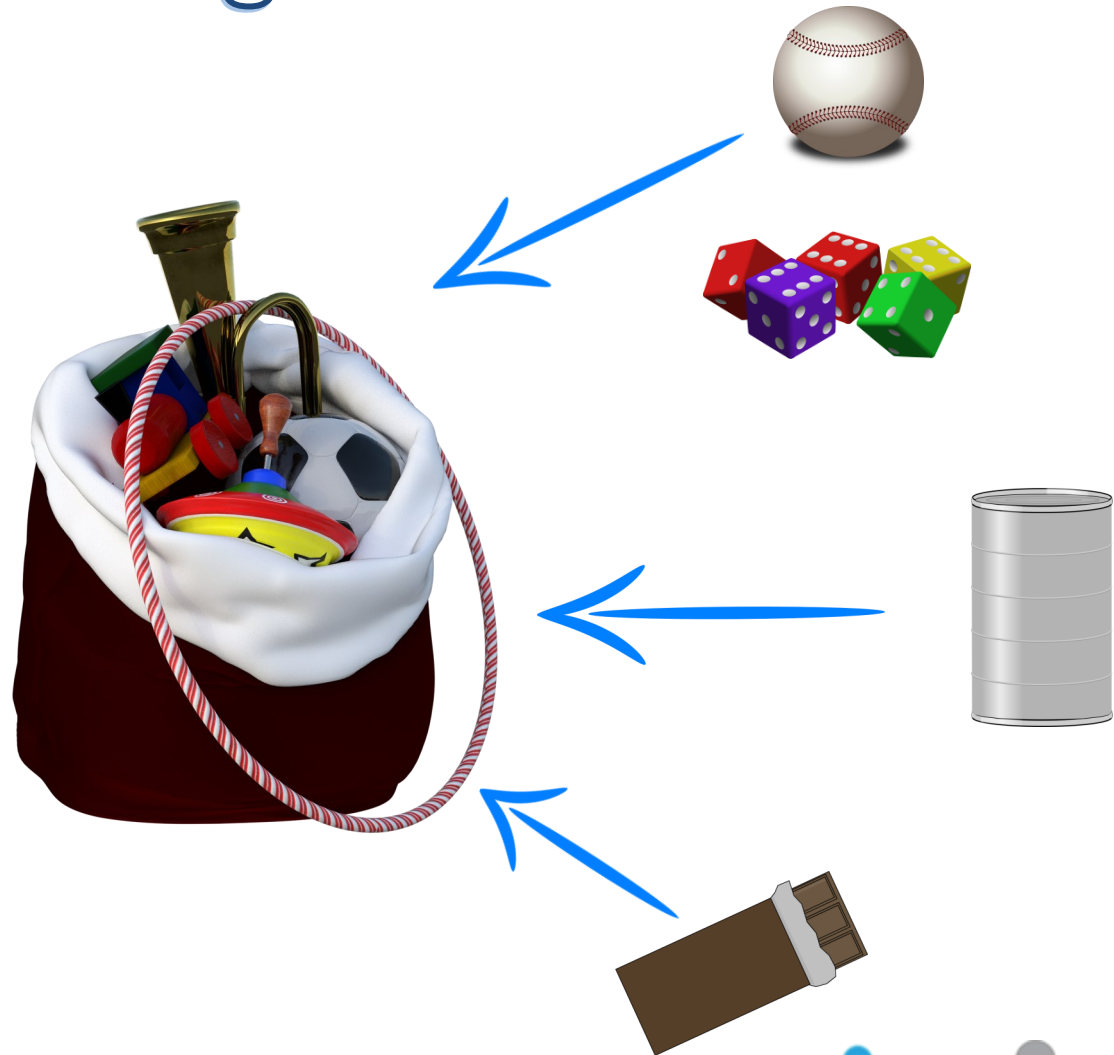


The Bag Game

Kids should close eyes and pull an item out, name it (vocabulary), describe it, answer who, what where, when and why questions about the item (language). Choose items with a sound you want them to practice (articulation). You can also just put one item in let them feel it and describe and guess the item (language).
